



Pennsylvania Longrifle Gunsmithing Class

Build a fine representation of a historic Pennsylvania Longrifle in this class taught by master gunsmiths Jim Correll, Rich Hujsa, and Rocky Schrek.

- Location: **Pennsylvania Longrifle Museum**, 403 Henry Road, Nazareth, PA.
- Dates & times: **Saturdays, March 6, 2010; from 2pm until 5pm**. Students should also plan time between sessions to work at home on their projects.
- Tuition: **\$750** per student + **membership in the Jacobsburg Historical Society**. Cost includes all instructor fees and parts necessary to build a basic, “lock-stock-and-barrel” Pennsylvania Longrifle. **Class size** limited to **8 students**, first come, first served. (A maximum of 4 students may attend class as observers only for a fee of \$250). **Tuition must be received by March 3, 2010.**
