

Beginning Powder Horn Building Class

Build a fine representation of an early period powder horn in this class taught by guild members of the Honourable Company of Horners. No prior experience or special knowledge required. Students will acquire the skills needed to build a powder horn with hand-tools and lathe. Course instructors are Frank Willis, Bob Albrecht, Bob Chattin, and Rich Hujsa.

- Location: **Pennsylvania Longrifle Museum**, 403 Henry Road, Nazareth, PA.
- Dates & times: **Saturdays, January 9-30, 2010; from noon until 5pm.** Students should also plan time between sessions to work at home on their projects.
- Tuition: **\$250** per student + **membership in the Jacobsburg Historical Society.** Cost includes all instructor fees, cow horn, tools, and any other necessary supplies and materials. **Class size limited to 8 students**, first come, first served. **Tuition must be received by December 18, 2010.**
